RE: Leonard Peltier- 89637-132

I refer you to Mr. Leonard Peltier, respectfully requesting that he is urgently transferred to a medium security prison.

Over the course of 8 months, USP 1 Coleman Florida, has gone into a lock down status on three separate occasions. Mr. Peltier's health is of serious concern and during the course of each lock down his health has deteriorated. He can no longer endure this cruel form of punishment.

Mr. Peltier's health needs are not properly addressed at his current facility. He was offered minimal guidance on his diabetes but the prison does not offer a nutritional program that fits the needs for this illness.

According to the Eight Amendment of the United States Constitution: Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.

He has received very few infractions in the 40 years he has been incarcerated. However, he faces dangers daily because of the environment he is forced to endure. He is a 71 year old elder with serious health concerns, of no threat to others, in need of a facility that will accommodate his need for proper medical attention in a safe environment.

I strongly urge you, to please transfer Mr. Peltier to a medium security facility.
